



## High Plains District Training Schedule August 2011 through October 2012



**Dear High Plains Scouters,**

**24 August 2011**

Trained leaders deliver higher quality programs resulting in greater *retention* of Scouts, rank advancement and utilization of outdoor program opportunities. BSA announced new training requirements for adults last year. Our goal is to train 100% of Top Leaders and direct contact leaders. **Top Leaders** include Scoutmasters, Cubmasters, Venturing Advisors and Varsity Coaches. **Direct Contact Leaders** are scouters who work directly with youth, including Den Leaders and all assistant leaders (Assistant Den Leaders, Assistant Cubmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, Assistant Coaches and Associate Advisors). The table below summarizes the new requirements to be considered "Trained" and wear the trained patch.

**Youth Protection** training is a high priority within BSA. Youth Protection Training is required prior to registration and must be renewed every two years. Those not trained or non-current will be unable to register with their unit at re-charter time. If you are registered in Venturing, you must take Venturing Youth Protection. On-line Youth Protection training is easy, convenient and only takes about 30 minutes.

**Individual training record validation** is available to all registered Scouters. Sign in with your user name and password at [www.myscouting.org](http://www.myscouting.org) and click on "Training Validation" on the left side of the page. Please contact me or any member of the training staff if you find a discrepancy in your record.

**We will do our best to provide you with the most current and worthwhile training possible.** Please watch the High Plains **PIONEER** newsletter and the new council and district web pages at <http://www.quivira.org/Districts.aspx> for dates and information.
