Activities?

The Medicine Lodge Peace Treaty re-enactment compresses 300 years of history into two hours of entertainment. The community of Medicine Lodge transforms into a frontier town, with parades, and the Medicine Lodge Historical Night show which re-enacts the Bank Robbery that took place in 1880's. This event is for all Boy Scouts and Venturing Crews.

When & Where

The camping location for Fall Camporee will be on Ted Lukens Ground, which is directly east of the Medicine Lodge Hospital located at 710 North Walnut Street, Medicine Lodge (there will be signs guiding you to the right area). Official check in will begin at 6:00 p.m. on Friday. Camping spots are available on a first come, first served basis. Camping style will be Pioneer Camping, so bring plenty of your own food and water.

Supervision?

All units must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines, and all registered leaders must have completed Youth Protection Training.

Cost?

Early Registration Fee is \$12 per Scout / \$12 per Adult through Tuesday, September 6th.
Regular fees of \$27 per Scout / \$27 per adult will apply beginning September 7th.

Refunds?

Refunds are not available, but can be transferred to another Scout or adult.

Registration?

Pre-registration and pre-payment are due no later than Tuesday, September 6th.
