What is it: The 15th Annual Quivira Council Merit Badge College offers an opportunity to work toward earning Merit Badges at Hutchinson Community College/Cosmosphere. Scouts are offered a diverse set of merit badges that will be either partially earned or completed on the day of the event. Scouts will be able to enroll in two separate merit badge classes of their choice and enrollments will be awarded on a first-come-first-served basis. Registration will only be taken online and be considered completed at time of payment. **Register early to increase the odds of getting into the classes that you want. Some classes fill very quickly.**

Lunch: Lunch is optional; individuals may choose to bring their own lunches. If bringing your own lunch, we recommend sack lunch. Lunch is available for \$5.00 and must be purchased at the time of registration.

Adult Needs: 2-Deep Leadership is required for your Troop. Adults may be asked to help in the classrooms as needed.

Registration: **Only online registrations will be accepted** and registration will be considered complete at time of payment which also must be completed online. Classes are always awarded on a first come, first served basis and availability is limited. Do not wait to register as classes will fill and be closed. Online registrations without payment will be deleted 72 hours after posted if payment is not made!! **Pre-registration is required.** NO PHONE REGISTRATIONS OR ADD ONS WILL BE ACCEPTED! NO REGISTRATION AT THE EVENT! Confirmation of all classes can be printed by unit leader. If additional confirmation is needed please make a request in writing to quincyj@cox.net. **Online registration is final!** No changes will be made once you submit, so take special care when registering. Once registration is confirmed, **we cannot make any changes to the schedule.** We reserve the right to cancel low-interest classes and will make accommodations accordingly. **(Classes subject to change)** Please register online at: www.tentaroo.com/quivira You must use Unit's preset log-on & password. Preparation: All Classes will have a worksheet that must be printed and brought with the Scout on the day of the event. These will be signed off by the Counselor and returned to the Scout. **It is the responsibility of the Scout to bring this and collect it from instructor when complete.** Areas highlighted in Yellow need to be completed outside of the classroom and will not be finished in class that day. Some requirements **MUST** be completed prior to the event. Please read over pre-requisites carefully to determine what can be completed prior to class. Unfinished merit badges must be completed at home by contacting an approved Merit Badge counselor, or by making arrangements with the counselor in charge that day. You may contact your Scout Master to find an approved counselor to assist with completion.

Fine Print: **Rules are subject to change; please regularly check the website for updates.**

- Purchasing and awarding of any merit badges earned will be the responsibility of the Troop.
- Each troop must have a minimum of 2 adult leaders present.
- Adult leaders will be expected to assist the counselor in checking outside work materials, recording class accomplishments, and maintaining the appropriate discipline and learning environment during the day. Behavior issues are not expected, however, if they occur, the Scout will be excused from class and escorted to an adult from his Troop.
- The official Boy Scout Field Uniform should be worn to help identify Scouts and leaders.
