What is it? This Quivira Council Nova Day will be located at Exploration Place in Wichita, and will bring together multiple community partners in an effort for Cub Scouts to get hands on experience getting “Down and Dirty!” *(limited to a total of only 100 Wolves, Bears and Webelos)*

Activities? Supervision? All Packs must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines and ALL adults must have completed Youth Protection Training.
