Family Camp for Cub Scouts, Webelos, and Arrow of Lights

- What is it?** South Winds Monster Mash is a fun-filled Halloween themed, 3-day and 2 night family camp for Cub Scouts, Webelos and Arrow of Light. Each day will provide the opportunity for your Scouts to have a new experience, with memories that will last a lifetime.
- Activities?** Activities planned include: Achievements and electives toward ranks as well as team building exercises and games. Activities will be changed as needed. Youth (and adults) are welcome and encouraged to wear costumes! **(No open toe/heel footwear)**
- Food?** **Food will not be provided.** All Packs need to bring their own food, food storage, and cooking equipment.
- When & Where?** October 20-22, 2017 Winfield Lake at the "Boy Scout" area on the North side of the Lake. Look for the signs when close. **Check-in begins at 7:00 P.M the first day of camp.**
- Supervision?** This is a family camp and it is intended that all youth participate with their families. All packs must have an adult/scout ratio of 1/5 and two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines and **all adults** must have completed Youth Protection Training prior to camp. Please bring a copy of all Adult Youth Protection cards to check-in.
- Cost?** Early bird Fee is \$10 per Scout and non-Scout youth (tagalongs) / \$5 per adult. Registration after September 19th will be \$20 per Scout and non-Scout youth (tagalongs) and \$10 per adult.
No registrations will be accepted after September 29th, 2017.
- Refunds?** Refunds are not available for this event.
- Registration?** Registration will open August 4th, online under *DISTRICT EVENTS* on Tentaroo. Pre-registration is required and **NO registrations OR add-ons will be accepted after registration closes September 29th, 2017 OR after capacity has been reached.** Please register at www.tentaroo.com/quivira. **Online payment is required** and may be made by credit card or electronic check. Parts A & B of the health forms are required and must be turned in for all participants at check in. Forms **will not** be provided onsite.
- Insurance?** Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance are provided for all registered youth and adult members of the Quivira Council.

Activities?	Events will utilize many Boy Scout outdoor skills (as required for Tenderfoot, Second and First Class Rank Advancements), plus other fun activities. Units will provide their own food & cook by patrol method.		
When & Where?	November 3 rd – 5 th , 2017. Check-in begins at 7 p.m. Friday night. Saturday activities will begin at 8 a.m. Camp will conclude at 12:00 noon on Sunday. Quivira Scout Ranch, 1781 Rd 19, Sedan, KS 67361		
Supervision?	All units must have two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection guidelines. Webelos and Arrow of Lights must have appropriate unit leadership and meet Webelos camping guidelines. Webelos, Arrow of Lights and leaders will camp with Troop of their choice.		
Cost?	Pre-registration Fee is \$10-youth / \$5-adult. Registrations after October 13 th will be \$20-youth / \$10-adult. All participants will receive a patch. <u>NO registrations will be accepted after October 20th, 2017.</u>		
Refunds?	Refunds are not available for this event.		
Registration?	Registration will open August 4 th , online under <i>DISTRICT CAMPOREES</i> on Tentaroo. Pre-registration is required in order for program materials and patches to be provided to all participants. Event is open to all registered Troops, Crews and Ships as well as Webelos and Arrow of Light Dens. Please register at www.tentaroo.com/quivira . Online payment is required and may be made by credit card or electronic check. Parts A & B of the health forms are required and must be turned in for all participants at check in.
