## South Winds Dist. Day Camp May 31 – June 2, 2018

### Enjoy the adventure of Day Camp at Mulvane Sports Complex

- What is it?** South Winds Day Camp is a fun-filled, three-day camp for Cub Scouts of all ages. Each day will provide the opportunity for your Scouts to have a new experience, with memories that will last a lifetime.
- Activities?** All activities are age appropriate and based on program level, including but not limited to archery, BB-gun target shooting, arts & crafts, awesome wood projects, games, songs, etc. Each youth will be working on advancements and electives toward their next rank. Each person will either need to pack a sack lunch each day or leave the event to eat lunch, except the 3<sup>rd</sup> day where a lunch will be provided. **Third day is family day where families are welcome** and will also be fed lunch. Each unit will need to provide an accurate count of how many additional family members will be joining for lunch that day.
- When & Where?** **May 31<sup>st</sup>-June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2018 in Mulvane, KS at the Mulvane Sports Complex** located at 955 E. 111<sup>th</sup> St. S, Mulvane KS 67110. (From Web and 111<sup>th</sup>, follow signs and go east to 95<sup>th</sup> street E. Go South and take the entrance on the East side of the park). \*\*If raining or thundering we will meet at the Derby LDS Stake located at 1409 S. Rock, Derby KS. Alternate activities will take place at that location until it is deemed safe to return outside. Check in will begin at 8:00 A.M. Camp runs from 8:45-2:45 each day, with exception of Saturday where camp will end after lunch.
- Supervision?** **All packs MUST have an adult/scout ratio of 1/5 and two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines and all adults must have completed Youth Protection Training prior to camp.** Please provide a copy of all Adult Youth Protection cards at check in first day. All Tigers must have an adult partner with them. Adults will help run stations. All parents are welcome on Parent's Day Saturday. Any non-registered adult attending more than parent's day must complete Youth Protection Training, bring a copy of Adult Youth Protection card with them to camp! **No Exceptions!** NO TAG ALONGS (other non-registered children)
- Registration?** **EVENT IS LIMITED TO 170 YOUTH!!!** Event is open to all Tiger Cubs thru Arrow of Light Scouts from all Packs, in or out of Council. Pre-registration is required in order for us to provide patches, cups, shirts and program materials to all youth participants as well as patches and shirts to adults. Please register online by the final deadline of **Wednesday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2018** with the Pack's preset-up Tentaroo account! Registration will be \$45/ youth and \$15/ adults. \*\* An additional \$5 will be charged for shirts over Adult XL in size. \*\*\* **No registrations will be accepted after April 25<sup>th</sup> as orders for materials must be placed by then. No Phone or email add-ons or registrations will be accepted. Registration is online only. Find the registration link at <http://www.quivira.org/camping> . Once on Tentaroo select **ALL DISTRICT DAY CAMPS: to continue.** Online payment is required and can be made by credit card or electronic check (use drop down arrow for selection) - Parts A & B of the health forms must be provided for all participants at check in. Parts A & B of the Health form are required. We will not provide forms onsite. Any person without completed health form will not be allowed to take part in the event. **Any persons not registered for the event will not be allowed to attend the event and will be asked to leave,** with the exception of the 3<sup>rd</sup> day where families are welcome.**
- Refunds?** No refunds are available for this event.
- Insurance?** Liability, as well as Sickness and Accident Insurance is provided for all registered youth and adult members of the Quivira Council.
