- What is it?** **Day Camp** is a fun-filled, two-day camp for Cub Scouts of all ages. Each day will provide a fun opportunity for your Scouts to have new experiences, with mighty adventures that will last a lifetime.
- Activities?** **Join the Scouts on this year's Adventure:** With building crafts, shooting sports (Archery, wrist-rockets and BB gun), and more!
- Webelos Overnight?** **All Webelos are invited to attend!** This will be at the same location and start at 4:30 on Friday. Bring a snack for hike, camping & cooking gear, large pill bottle/watertight container, Class A uniform, proper clothing, supper ingredients to make a camp meal.
- When & Where?** **Friday & Saturday, June 8 & 9, 2018:** Check-in begins at 8:30 a.m. the first day of camp. Camp runs 9-4 each day. The Overlook at Bill Hill Lake – Cherryvale, KS
- Health Forms?** **Parts A & B of the BSA Health Form** is required for all scouts and adults. Forms must be turned in at check in. Blank forms will not be provided.
- Cost?** **Early Bird Registration by May 8, 2017 is \$30 per Scout & Adult** (Includes T-shirt, cup and patch) **\$10 Tag-A-Longs.** After Early Bird prices are \$40 per Scout & Adult and will not guarantee a T-shirt cup or patch.
- Food?** **No meals will be provided. Please bring a sack lunch for the members of your pack both days.**
- Supervision?** All units must have an adult/scout ratio of 1/5 and two-deep leadership in accordance with Youth Protection Guidelines and all adults must have completed Youth Protection Training prior to camp. Please bring a copy of all Adult Youth Protection certification to check-in.
- Registration?** **Pre-registration is required** in order for us to provide patches and cups to all youth participants. Event is open to all Quivira Council Packs. **Registration may be done online**

- Insurance?** Liability, as well as sickness and accident insurance are provided for all registered youth and adult members of Quivira Council.

You can reserve a site by calling (620) 336-2741, these sites will provide you with some utilities and swimming. There is a Scout only camp site but it is a first come first serve area with not utilities.
